Reading

Maths

You will still have Daily Maths to do, this will be posted daily onto Seesaw as usual and paper copies are available in your home learning packs.

You will notice that in your pack I have added the Power Maths book which we do in class, I have also added some sheets of the slides you would usually see on the board. Each day, there will be a teacher video posted on to seesaw for you to follow about that lesson. I will also post the answers onto Seesaw, please mark your work and don't forget to correct any mistakes.

English
