I can write a biography about an American film star.

I can write an information booklet about the landmarks of North America.

I can become a Space Presenter providing explanations and sharing my knowledge about space. (TV Broadcast)

I can write a poem with a structure based on our North America theme.

I can describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.

I can describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.

I can describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies.

I can use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

I can use practical scientific methods, processes and skills outlined in the programme of study for Year 5 and Year 6.

I can build a scaled model of the solar system/ I can make a sundial.

I can locate North America's environmental regions, most significant human and physical features, countries and major cities.
