

Water Primary School Short Visits



During the course of the school year, all children may, at different times, carry out study in the immediate vicinity of the school to support work in History, Geography, Science and Health Education. In addition, there is a termly rota for taking each class to a local swimming pool, usually Marl Pits, for swimming lessons as part of the statutory Physical Education Curriculum.

We are not allowed to take children off the premises without permission from parents, however, it would be inappropriate to send out letters with permission slips for all of these activities, particularly when we often have to take our opportunities for this sort of work when the weather is fine so decisions have to be taken at short notice.

I am therefore asking you to complete attached permission form giving us permission to:

- a) Take your child swimming
- b) include your child in work off the premises but in the immediate location of the school, i.e. in the area stretching from Lumb Baptist's Church to Water Park on Burnley Road East, and behind the school as far as the top of Dean Lane
- c) Forest School visits
- d) Running club

Our School Policy sets out the procedures and supervision requirements for **all** school visits. Any visit to more distant locations will require separate permission and advance notification of all the arrangements.
