- Provide a safe and happy environment to help and encourage your child.
- Have high expectations of your child's effort, achievement and behaviour.
- Apply school rules and policies fairly (copies are available on request).
- Work with outside agencies in order to meet the needs of your child.
- Be open and welcoming and offer you opportunities to become involved in the life of the school.
- Provide regular information about school events and your child's progress, so encouraging the partnership between home and school.
- Encourage your child to behave safely and responsibly outside school by developing awareness of Road Safety and safe play issues.
- Apply appropriate Child Protection Procedures should we have any concerns about a child.
