Scarecrow & Pumpkin Trail in the Forest School Monday 20th October from 3.30pm to 5.30pm



We are just writing to remind you about our Scarecrow & Pumpkin Trail in the Forest School next Monday after school from 3.30pm until 5.30pm.

Thank you to all the families who have confirmed, via payment on Parent Pay, that they will be bringing a scarecrow or pumpkin (or both!) – we are really looking forward to seeing everyone's spooky designs!

Just a reminder for those who haven't yet entered, and who would still like to take part, the cost to enter the competition will be £3.00 per scarecrow and £1.00 per pumpkin (payable via Parent Pay), with all funds raised going to Friends of Water. There will be **prizes on offer for the best designs.**

Scarecrows and pumpkins are to be brought to school next Monday morning and left on the yard at the front of school and our lovely Friends of Water volunteers will take them up to the Forest to decorate ready for the trail after school. Please make sure your scarecrows and pumpkins are clearly marked with your child's name so we can identify any winners.

You don't need to have a scarecrow or pumpkin in the competition to join in the trail – all families and friends are invited to go up to the trail after school, and have a look at all amazing scarecrows and pumpkins. Entry into the trail will be £1.00.

There will also be a refreshment stand at the cabin, where Friends of Water will be serving hot dogs and hot drinks (juice for the children), together with their tuck shop.

We would advise that, due to the time of year, everyone wraps up warm with good walking/wellington boots and brings a torch. Whilst in the forest all children will be the responsibility of their accompanying adult.

We are very excited about this and hope, if it is successful, it can become an annual event for our school community. We can't wait to see the results!
