- As we approach February we would like to remind parents of our Severe Weather Policy. In the case of severe weather, that causes a risk to children and teacher's safety as they travel to school then school will make the decision to close. This will be communicated before 8:00am via a text message and the local radio station. The school will never take this decision lightly and will only close if the safety of the children would be compromised.
- We have made the decision to discontinue the use of Doodle Maths as a tool to support children's learning at home. This decision is based on very low usage and increased subscription costs. We are still running several maths schemes in school to support our maths curriculum.
- Since the introduction of a no booking policy for Breakfast Club, we have seen a significant increase in the number of children attending. The children who attend have commented on how they are much more prepared for the day and it is also easing a bit of congestion at bell time. If there are any parents who are interested in using breakfast club, bring your child along any day (no need to book).
